## 3 Faux Ripped Paper

#### **Basic Supplies:**

- Masking Paper or sticky notes
- Blending brushes, daubers, or sponges
- Cardstock
- Ink
- Stamps

#### **Dimensions for sample card:**

Daffodil Delight: 8 ½" x 5 ½"
Sweet Sorbet: 3 7/8" x 5 1/8"

• Basic White: 3 3/4" x 5"

### Technique:

- 1. Tear the edge off of a piece of Masking Paper that is about  $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " 2" wide.
- 2. Adhere the Masking Paper to the cardstock.
- 3. Using a Blending Brush or other blending tool, color a light color over the torn edge.
- 4. Stamp images.
- 5. Remove Masking Paper.
