STAMPING TECHNIQUES

6 Four-Square Card

Supplies:

- Cardstock (base): (2) 8 1/2" x 11"
- Coordinating Cardstock (layer): (4) 3 7/8" x 5 1/8"
- Coordinating Cardstock (sentiment): 3 1/8" x 3/4"
- White or vanilla cardstock: 10" x 7 1/2"
- White or vanilla cardstock (sentiment): 3" x 5/8"
- White or vanilla cardstock (interior): (4) 5 1/4" x 4"
- Bold, multi-directional stamps (flowers, leaves, snowflakes, etc.)
- Ink
- Adhesive
- Stampin' Dimensionals
- Embellishments (optional)



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Technique:

1. Starting at the center, stamp randomly down the middle of the white or vanilla cardstock each direction (horizontally and vertically).
2. Cut your white or vanilla cardstock in half each direction. i.e. at 5" and at 3 3/4".
3. Adhere each piece of white or vanilla cardstock on a piece of coordinating cardstock (layer).
4. Score each piece of cardstock (base) at 4 1/4". Then cut in half at 5 1/2". Fold each of the four pieces of cardstock in half.
5. Adhere each layered stamped piece to one card front.
6. Adhere a white or vanilla piece (interior) to the inside of each card.
7. Stamp a sentiment on each piece of white or vanilla cardstock (sentiment).
8. Adhere each sentiment to a piece of coordinating cardstock (sentiment).
9. Using Stampin' Dimensionals, adhere a sentiment to the front of each card.

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
