Envelope Flap Card



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Basic Dimensions & Supplies:

Cardstock (base): 5 1/2" x 4 1/4"
Cardstock (folded): 10 1/2" x 4", score at 2 5/8" and 7 7/8"
White or vanilla cardstock: 5" x 3 3/4"
Patterned paper: 5" x 5 1/4"
A medium/small punch or die-cut shape
Paper Trimmer
Stamps, ink, adhesive

Tips:

1. Fold the cardstock (folded) on the score lines to create a gatefold.
2. Stamp the front with a pattern and the inside of the flaps.
3. Score the patterned paper on the 5" side at 1".
4. Make a small cut in the patterned paper opposite the fold at 2 5/8".
5. Put your patterned paper in your paper trimmer. Line up the cut in the cutting groove. Line up the corner next to the score line at the 1" mark. Cut. Do the same thing on the other side. This will create a triangle flap.
6. Fold the patterned paper on the score line. Attach the small flap to the back of the cardstock (folded).
7. Attach the cardstock (folded) to the cardstock (base).
8. Punch or die-cut a small to medium shape.
9. Stamp a sentiment on the punched or die-cut shape.
10. Using a Stampin' Dimensional, adhere the shape to one flap of the cardstock (folded) so that it holds down the pointed flap of the patterned paper without sticking to it.

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
